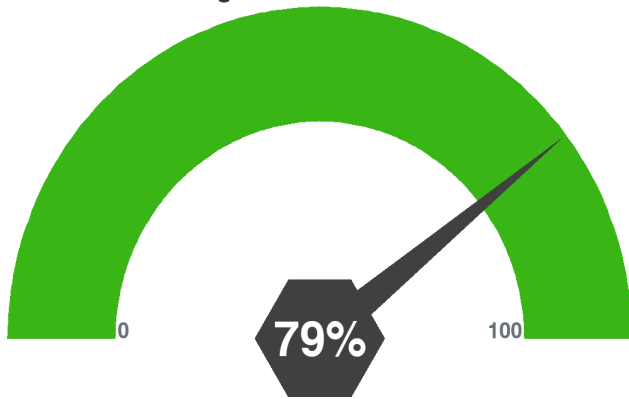

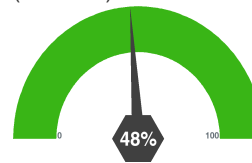

Performance Compared to Other Test Takers

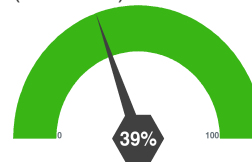
Percentile Ranking

Interpreting the Candidate's Score

There are 20 errors that candidates must identify in the proofreading test. When the candidate fails to identify an error (e.g., Errors Not Identified), they are deducted one point for every error they do not identify. Every time the candidate selects a word or punctuation mark that is not an error (e.g., Misidentified Non-Errors), they are deducted one point every time they misidentify a non-error. For example, if a candidate correctly identifies 15 errors and selects 2 words that are not errors, the candidate's score is 13/20, or 65%. You will notice these scores are further broken down by error type in sections 2 and 3 of the report.
